Location: Sweet Cheeks Winery Tasting Room at the 5th Street Public Market - 4:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m.

It’s time to have some fun and celebrate! Enjoy music and specials, team awards will be presented to the winners in each team category, and prize winners can pick up their prizes!

TEAMS

Each team is put into one of six team size categories according to the number of members on the team. The top three teams in each category, based on the highest **Team Score**, will receive a 1st, 2nd, or 3rd place award.

X Small: 2-6 **Small:** 7-12 **Medium:** 13-25 **Large:** 26-75 **X-Large:** 76-249 **XX-Large:** 249+

The team size consists of 100% of your employees in your department or organization (depends on if you are signing up as a department or as an entire organization).

Example: If the Finance Department has 30 people in their department but only 8 will participate in the BCC, the Finance Department Team size is 30 and will compete against other teams in the **Large** team size category.

The **Team Score** is calculated as follows:

- *Number of Trips / Number of Team Members = Team Score*
- *Number of Trips = one-way trips to work that team members commute to work by walking, biking, busing, pooling or clicking (Any mode except driving alone) for the BCC week.*
- *Number of Team Members = the total number of people on a team regardless if they are not registered*
- *Team Score = the average commute per person*

Example:

Team A has 25 team members. They log 102 alternative one-way commute trips during the BCC week.

Team A’s score would be calculated as follows:

$$102 \text{ commute trips} / 25 \text{ team members} = \text{A team score of } 4.08$$
